1. **STATUTORY INFORMATION**

SD Software Developers Limited is a private company, limited by shares, registered in England and Wales. The company's registered number and registered office address can be found on the Company Information page.

2. **ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

Basis of preparing the financial statements

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standard 102 "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland" including the provisions of Section 1A "Small Entities" and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Turnover

Turnover represents amounts receivable for goods and services net of vat and trade discounts.

Intangible assets

Intangible assets are initially measured at cost. After initial recognition, intangible assets are measured at cost less any accumulated amortisation and any accumulated impairment losses.

Development costs are being amortised evenly over their estimated useful life of seven years.

Development expenditure

An intangible asset arising from the development of software is recognised only if the following conditions are met:

It is probable that the asset will create future economic benefit;

The development costs can be measured reliably;

The technical feasibility of completing the intangible asset can be demonstrated;

There is the intention to complete the asset and use or sell it;

There is the ability to use or sell the asset and;

Adequate technical, financial and other resources to complete the development and to use or sell the asset are available.

Where an intangible asset cannot be recognised, development expenditure is charged to the profit and loss account in the period in which it is incurred.

Where an asset is capitalised amortisation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost less estimated residual value of each asset over its expected useful life being 7 years.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Plant and machinery etc - 33% on cost and 25% on cost

Taxation

Taxation for the year comprises current and deferred tax. Tax is recognised in the Income Statement, except to the extent that it relates to items recognised in other comprehensive income or directly in equity.

Current or deferred taxation assets and liabilities are not discounted.

Current tax is recognised at the amount of tax payable using the tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the balance sheet date.

2. **ACCOUNTING POLICIES - continued**

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date.

Timing differences arise from the inclusion of income and expenses in tax assessments in periods different from those in which they are recognised in financial statements. Deferred tax is measured using tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the year end and that are expected to apply to the reversal of the timing difference.

Unrelieved tax losses and other deferred tax assets are recognised only to the extent that it is probable that they will be recovered against the reversal of deferred tax liabilities or other future taxable profits.

Pension costs and other post-retirement benefits

The company operates a defined contribution pension scheme. Contributions payable to the company's pension scheme are charged to profit or loss in the period to which they relate.

Going concern

The Director has considered the impact of the global Covid-19 pandemic on the ability of the Company to continue trading for the foreseeable future. This review has included considering the impact of the pandemic to the date of signing the financial statements and updating financial projections and performing rigorous stress testing on these projections in respect of income and the company's supply chain. Based on this review and taken together with existing financing facilities, the Director believes that the financial statements have been prepared appropriately on the going concern basis.

The Director believes that sufficient funding will continue to be provided to meet the operating costs of the company for a period of at least 12 months from the approval of these financial statements.

On this basis, the Director is satisfied as to the going concern status of the Company.
